

Latin crash course


- No universal standardized common names
- Species Plantarum, 1753 by Carl von Linné.
- Classical Ecclesiastical National
- No universal way to pronounce Latin

Echium vulgare Snake's head (Slangehoved/Ormehode) DK/NO Blue Flame (Blåeld) SE



Scientific names pronounced

- Callitris glaucophylla
- Pinus thunbergii
- Juniperus squamata 'Prostrata'
- Chamaecyparis obtusa
- Callistemon viminalis
- Leptospermum trinervium
- Crataegus phaenopyrum
- Ligustrum undulatum
- Styrax japonicus
